Welcome, to Irion County ISD Cafeteria! We are excited about the opportunity to get to know you and we are looking forward to a happy and productive school year.

Cafeteria Policy: *(All Policies are subject to change)*

- ❖ **All students are required to have an ID card when coming through the serving line.**
 - This is to make sure that the student is present at the time of purchase and the correct student.
 - **Cafeteria personnel will not be responsible for keeping up with the cards.**
- ❖ Each student will need to either scan the barcode or enter their ID# on the pin pad in front of the register
 - The ID cards will have the following information:
 - Student name
 - Barcode and ID#
- ❖ If the card is lost or damaged and cannot be scanned properly then they will be issued another one for a small fee.

Offer vs Serve Policy:

- ❖ Irion County ISD allows the students to have the option of choice. The student is allowed to choose what they want to eat when going through the service line. In order to continue this the students must be aware that they have to choose the required components. The students that do not choose the required components will then be ask to pay for them. The following chart shows what the students are able to choose from:
 - **Lunch:** *Consists of 5 components, they must choose 3 components for this to be a reimbursable meal.*
 - ◆ ****Of the 3 components, one choice must be a fruit or fruit juice and/or vegetable**
 - **Breakfast:** *3 Components must be chosen for a reimbursable meal.*
 - ◆ ****Of the 3 Components, one choice must be a fruit or fruit juice.**

Cafeteria Charges:

- ❖ **The Student Charge Limit for the Current School year will be:** ⇒ **NO CHARGING**
ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A POSITIVE BALANCE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL AND CONTINUE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.
- ❖ We ask that you please keep your student account balances current. The student accounts are on a continued cycle therefore more charges will accrue on a daily basis.
 - *If a parent fails to prepay or provide cash for the student to pay on site, the student will be limited to charges of only (3) meals. Once the (3) three meal limit has been met students will be provided with an alternative meal for three days only*
- ❖ **Parents who continue to fail in providing the student with the funds to purchase a meal or do not provide a lunch form home, the proper authorities will be contacted to report this neglect**
- ☒ **You will receive notifications via email or mail on current balances.** *(Please check the date of the correspondence as you may receive more than one.)*

Payments: We strongly encourage account payments to be paid on line at myschoolbucks.com Checks are the most secure way to transport payment between home and school. All cash brought from home is given to the teachers then to Food Service Director.
